

**CITY OF WILDOMAR
PLANNING COMMISSION VACANCY**

On June 12, 2019 one vacancy on the Planning Commission was declared by the City Council. The term of this vacancy runs concurrent with the appointing Council Member's term which will end in December, 2020. The Planning Commission is comprised of five members and serves at the pleasure of the City Council. Each Council Member appoints a member to the Planning Commission, which is then voted upon by the entire City Council. The vacancy will be appointed by Mayor Pro Tem Dustin Nigg. The Planning Commissioner is not required to live in the same district as the appointing Council Member.

Planning Commissioners will be expected to make potentially significant time commitments to both learning the job of Planning Commissioner, as well as regular attendance at Planning Commission meetings. Regular Planning Commission meetings are held on the first Wednesday of each month, starting at 6:30 p.m., however there are also special meetings and workshops that could be called as well. Commissioners are paid \$75 per meeting attended.

Qualifications for Planning Commissioners are:

- 1) Must be a registered voter at their current address;
- 2) Must be a resident within the City limits of Wildomar;
- 3) Must be a resident within the City limits of Wildomar for the year immediately preceding the inception of his/her term; and
- 4) May not be an employee or officer of the City of Wildomar.
