STAFF REPORT

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council select and approve two Councilmembers to serve on a temporary Ad-Hoc Subcommittee to participate in a Regional Cities COVID-19 Economic Recovery Task Force.

DISCUSSION:

Recent discussions with other cities in the Southwest Riverside County region have led to an interest in working together to address COVID-19 based impacts common to local government. The cities of Canyon Lake, Lake Elsinore, Menifee, Murrieta and Temecula would work together to develop models and plans to address local businesses economic recovery, fiscal and service level impacts to local government and quality of life issues. The City of Wildomar has previously participated in numerous regional committees which successfully addressed issues and staff recommends that Council nominate and appoint two City Council members to this Ad-Hoc Subcommittee. At the completion of this COVID-19 event, this subcommittee will disband.
